DANCE CHANGES EVERYTHING

Garlynda's Fancy Feet, is a studio that offers experience, skill and professional integrity through its dedicated faculty. We provide a family oriented atmosphere, which ensures a quality dance education for every student. Our school focuses on building self-esteem and character amongst the students.

Our doors are always open; our love for dance has been a lifetime passion. It is not always about being the best dancer but being the dancer that can be created through desire, dedication, and discipline. Our studio's environment includes constructive criticism, emphasis on stage presence, the love of dance, and let us not forget FUN!

GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

TUITION:

- *Classes are billed by the month and fees are due the first dance class of the month.*
- *No refunds for missed classes. One must pay for all classes whether the child attends all classes or not.*
- *If a child attends one class in the month and then decides to quit, full tuition for the month is expected.*
- *There will be a late fee of \$10.00 added each month on all accounts that are 10 days late from payment date. 15th of the month*
 - Includes tuition, costumes, and any money owed to the studio*
- *Families with more than one child receives a 10% discount (tuition only)*
- *When paying by check, place check in an envelope with child's name on the check and indicate what check is written for. Place the name of the child on the outside of the envelope.*
 - Fill out a GFF voucher each time a payment is made.*
- *Place payment, voucher, and envelope in the mailbox in the dance area of the studio.*
- *If paying by check that is your receipt.*
- *If paying by cash, place cash in envelope with voucher. A receipt is given the following week.*
- *Options:*
 - Attached form filled out, signed and returned*

New This Year: we will be accepting payment from Pay Pal (However, there will be a \$5.00 processing fee that must be added to the total of monthly tuition or costumes. Example: if tuition is \$50 by using

Pay Pal you will pay \$55.00 for processing

May also make payments through messenger

A service charge of \$30.00 will be placed on all returned checks

All money owed to FANCY FEET must be paid before recital

DRESS CODE:

Required:

- *Leotards, tights, crop tops, dance pants, or Capri pants of any color*
- *Pink ballet shoes (elastic attached across the instep)*
- *Black tap shoes*
 - When instructed tan low heel buckle tap shoes or black jazz tap*
- *Tan split sole jazz shoes (when instructed)*
- *Lyrical shoes (when instructed)*
- *Hair must be up tight in a bun, ponytail or braid. (All hair must be off the neck and out of face at all times)*



- NO T-SHIRTS!!!! They can be worn as a cover up, but not during dance class
- Dance shorts (not jeans) may be worn if other dance clothes such as tights, crop tops, or leotards are worn
- Sweat pants and T-shirts may be worn as a cover up only
- No jewelry. (Includes big earrings, bracelets, necklaces, etc.)

Optional

Leg warmers, socks, sweatshirts or pants, dance bags, any other dance accessories approved by instructor

*****If not dressed appropriately for dance class the dancer will not be permitted to dance during class. NO EXCEPTIONS. We are here to dance not set a fashion statement. You are a dancer and should dress as a dancer.

*****Cover-ups are required coming and going from the studio at all times. No one is to enter or leave the studio in just dance clothes

COSTUMES:

- \$50.00 costume deposit is due the week of November 1st
(NON-REFUNDABLE) this deposit will be subtracted from the total price of costumes
- Each dancer is required to have complete costume as instructed. This includes: shoes (Color), earrings, sequins, tights, costumes, hair, and other accessories needed.
- Costumes are ordered during the months of December and January.
- Measurements will be taken for costumes in early November bust waist, hips and girth)
- If deposits are not made by November 30th costumes will not be ordered

Costume Payment Plan

- full payment January 15th (less the deposit)
- 2 payments 1st January 15th balance January 29th
- Can pay \$20 or more each month

There will be a \$10 late fee per month added to the balance due of costumes after February 1st

ATTENDANCE:

- Attendance is required
- No make-up classes for classes missed by the individual
- A dancer must be in attendance 3/4 of the dance class to be considered present for the class.
- Call dance studio and leave a message, a text message to my cell phone (691-6087), call or text or send a message via email or Facebook to inform instructor if the child will not be attending dance class that day

CALENDAR:

- The Alleghany County School System calendar is followed
- If school is out for bad weather—NO DANCE
- If school is dismissed early due to bad weather—NO DANCE
- A calendar will be sent home with scheduled events
- Call dance studio phone line or check Face Book for messages relating to cancellations or other related in
- There will be no make-up days for days missed due to bad weather
(Exception: If a given dance class day misses more than 4 days due to weather---one day will be made up (for every four cancellations)
- There may be times that switching of day and time of dance class is necessary. Memos will be sent home in advance.



DISCIPLINE:

- The dancer will be given a warning if she misbehaves. (Class rules are explained the first dance Class)
- If behavior does not improve, the child will be placed in the designated "BAD GIRLS' CORNER"
- If this does not resolve the matter, parent will be contacted and methods of discipline will be Discussed

- *In the case of the older dancers, they will be given a warning. If behavior does not improve, they will be asked to leave the class----not the building. They will be required to sit in the waiting area for the remainder of class. Parent will be contacted*

MISBEHAVIOR WILL NOT BE TOLERATED!!!

CODE OF CONDUCT

All students and parents are expected to conduct themselves in a courteous and respectable manner at all times. Gossiping by a student or a parent about other students, parents, staff members or other studios is not tolerated. Disrespecting a faculty member or another student or being discourteous to a fellow student is grounds for disciplinary action that may result in probation, suspension or being asked to leave the studio permanently. In the event that you are asked to not return to the studio there will be no reimbursement for any classes, or any other fees collected by the studio. If your costume is paid in full but has not come in yet, we will call you when it comes in and you can pick up the costume or costumes.

Legal Disclaimer

Garlynda's Fancy Feet , Faculty and Staff members will not accept responsibility for any injuries sustained by any dancer during the course of dancing. Common Dance injuries that occur at studios are Broken Ankles, Sprained Ankles, Chins being fallen on and split open and so on. Garlynda's Fancy Feet Faculty and Staff members will not accept responsibility for any injuries sustained by any dancer during the course of any exhibition, competition, or convention in which he or she may participate, or while traveling to or from an exhibition, competition, or convention, or class time. All students and parents are required to sign a legal disclaimer.



MISCELLANEOUS:

NO SMOKING IN THE BUILDING

Upon arrival at the dance studio, enter on COMMERCIAL AVENUE. Wait in waiting area and put on dance shoes

*Dancers should go to restroom prior to the beginning of dance class.
Dancers will only be permitted to use restroom when changing dance shoes
(***There will be exceptions and emergencies)*

No children are permitted on the second floor at any time without adult supervision and not informing the instructor.

No food, chewing gum, or candy permitted during dance class. Water bottles are recommended for the older dancers. Only classes that have been instructed may drink these during class

Keep waiting area clean!!!!

There are soft drinks and bottled water (\$1.00) for sale in the waiting area. Sometimes there are snacks or candy for sale. Please pay for these items when purchased. Place money in designated containers

Be on time for class.

Be on time when picking up your child.

It is recommended that if you are the last class of the evening; arrive 5 minutes earlier than dismissal time to pick up your child. The last class of the evening will exit out the front door on MAIN STREET. Everyone in that class will exit at same time. Studio doors will be locked 15 minutes after the last dance class of the evening begins.

We will not be responsible for unattended children. Your child will not be permitted to leave the building unless accompanied by an adult. (Safety purposes)

NO ONE IS PERMITTED in the dance area during dance classes except for instructors, assistants and dancers

Keep small children away from door entrance during class.

Be prepared for class. Be dressed in dance clothes. Ballet is always first unless indicated by instructor.

There will be days when instructors will be unable to teach. We have several assistants who are very capable and trustworthy of handling the dance classes while we are gone. These ladies are very responsible and talented individuals. Please give them your respect (this includes parents and dancers)

Parents wishing to stay during their child's dance class may stay in the waiting area. Please refrain from talking loudly. This distracts the dancers and instructors,

If you need to speak with me after hours, please do not call me on my home phone, Cell # 540-691-6087

If you would like to sell your daughter's shoes and dance items, you can place them in zip lock bags with your name and the price. The money will be placed in the bag and given to your daughter at the next dance class.

2nd hand shoes and dance items are for sale the studio. Place money in the provided bag and give to instructor.

There will be many times when we may be asked to perform for local charities or events. This is an honor and privilege. I hope you will make every effort to permit your child to take place in these events. Some events and charities we have danced at in the past include: Fall Festival, Bike Rodeo, Brian Center, Streetscene, Labor Day festivities, local pageants, nursing homes and other local events.

This gives the dancer other opportunities to perform their recital number and wear their costumes.
